

# Music Makers Choir Registration

For Boys and Girls, Ages Six, Seven and Eight – Must be Six by October 15

## Registration Deadlines

**All choristers – April 24, 2013 – *one form per child***

**Voice Checks – May 2, 2013 – 12:30-2:00 pm in Groom’s Room at Christ Covenant**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:** Music Makers must be able to sing back a pattern of 5 -7 notes, sing from “A” below middle C to “E” one octave above middle C, sing the chorus of “Jesus Loves Me” and move up in half steps while singing fragments of the tune. All prospective Music Makers should come to voice check prepared to sing a simple folk tune solo. If you do not know if your child can meet these requirements, please ask a musical friend to help you decide before you come to the voice check. Students must be able to sit still and receive instructions.

**IMPORTANT: \*\*\*** All parents must read, agree to and sign the *CHEA Choir Requirements and Behavior Guidelines* (separate attachment found on Music Makers tab at <http://www.cheaonline.com/choir.html>). Return signed portion with this with your registration form and fee.

A registration fee of \$40 must ***be paper clipped or stapled*** to this form to reserve your space. Upon confirmation of choir membership, after voice check, the \$40 is non-refundable. ## VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. All choir communication will be via email so you **MUST** check email regularly.
2. Please mark your calendar for the mandatory parent meeting on Tuesday, Sept. 3, 2013 3:30pm. Children will be in choir on this day.
3. Uniform fee of \$10 for all girls. Also – ALL Music Makers girls must pay a \$40 security deposit for red jumpers.
4. Parents agree to teach song words & hymns to students and agree to play the CD 3-4 times per week.

\_\_Assistant Director – will direct when Director is absent

\_\_Accompanist – plays piano for rehearsal/concerts – must be prepared with repertoire and able to sight read music.

\_\_Carrington Contact – Calls Carrington Place Nursing Home to reserve days/times for our Carrington Ministry. Check with Director for dates.

\_\_Choir Administrator – Assists Director with Admin work; puts info on Big Tent.

\_\_CD Maker – Burns choir CD's and replaces lost CD's for \$2.50 per CD

\_\_Concert Parent – Helps during the concert – takes children to bathroom and makes sure everyone is behaving.

\_\_Copier – Responsible for making copies of various hand-outs.

\_\_Drama coordinator – Works with choristers that might have speaking parts. Also helps with blocking on stage and takes notes during rehearsals.

\_\_Hymn Listening Coordinator – Keeps Hymn bag and coordinates Hymn Listener moms.

\_\_Hymn Listeners – We need 3 moms to do this at the end of choir 2 times/month

\_\_Monitor Moms – Assists students in breaks for bathroom and water, make-up hymn listening, or first aid (if needed). Sits with choristers and actively helps Director during rehearsals, - ie – games.

\_\_Name Tags – Purchase sticky back name tags for use the first month of choir. Writes children's names on tags so they are ready to go choir day, each of the first 4 weeks. Expense from choir fund.

\_\_Phone Chain – develops a phone chain list for parents in case any messages, such as inclement weather, reminders or cancellations occur.

\_\_Props Coordinator – Responsible for acquiring/assembling needed props for programs or concerts & works with director. Expense from choir fund.

\_\_Social Coordinators (3) - Plans and coordinates parties/socials for the year. May determine food, assign food and arrange facilities. One coordinator for each party” Fall, Valentines and End-of-Year.

\_\_Thank-you gifts – Purchase thank you gifts for workers each semester. Discuss with director who receives these gifts. Expense from choir fund.

\_\_Uniform coordinator – Keeps track of uniforms. Responsible for giving right size uniform to each student in Fall and collecting clean uniforms after Spring Concert.
